



Your Guide to Trash Disposal and Recycling in the City of Santa Clarita

SERVICE

- Residents should place all carts out at curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Carts should be placed three feet apart and three feet from any obstruction, with the lid opening facing the street.
- *Trash:* Place trash in your 96-gallon blue container.
- *Recycling:* Place your glass, aluminum, paper (including newspaper, scrap paper, and junk mail) cardboard and plastics in your gray cart with the green lid for proper disposal of recyclable materials.
- *Greenwaste:* Recycle your greenwaste by placing loose yard waste materials in your charcoal gray 96-gallon greenwaste container.
- Additional Recycling and/or Greenwaste carts are available at no additional charge. Contact Customer Service at (661) 259-2398 for more information.

BULKY ITEM PICKUP

- Waste Management will pick up your bulky items including old couches, refrigerators, TVs, monitors and stoves (up to four free per year). Please call Customer Service at (661) 259-2398 48 hours in advance of your regularly scheduled pickup day to schedule your bulky item pick up.
- Customers are allowed four bulky item pickups per year with a limit of three bulky items per pickup.
- Additionally, bulky items can be dropped off for free at the Waste Management facility (25772 Springbrook Road) Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- Electronic Waste, such as monitors and old TVs can be collected.

MANURE RECYCLING

- Contact Customer Service at (661) 259-2398 for more information regarding manure recycling.

TRASH

- Filled carts must weigh less than 250 pounds full, and materials should be loosely packed so that your carts will empty easily when overturned.
- Do not place rocks, concrete, dirt, hazardous waste or electronic waste in your carts.
- If your cart is overweight, the driver will attempt to service it and notify you by leaving an Important Notice tag attached to the cart. If however, we are unable to empty the cart, the cart will be tagged overweight and you will need to lighten the contents for the following week's service.
- Please remember your street sweeper will pass through your neighborhood the day after your collection day, once every other week.

EXTRA BAGS

- Up to eight times per year, WM/Blue Barrel will pick up three extra bags from your curb at no additional charge. The extra pickups must be scheduled 24 hours advance by calling Customer Service at (661) 259-2398.

HOLIDAYS

- Waste Management observes six holidays that may affect trash and recycling services. For the week of New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day, collection will be one day later than usual, unless the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday.
- Waste Management provides FREE Holiday Tree Recycling services starting December 26th through the second Saturday in January.

Recycling

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR RECYCLING

- Aluminum and tin cans
- Rinsed milk and juice cartons - flattened
- Carryout bags, butter and margarine tubs, screw on caps and yogurt containers
- Plastic food containers marked #1 - #7
- Mixed plastic materials
- Shampoo, detergent, milk, soda, water, etc.
- Cereal and cracker boxes, cardboard and corrugated boxes
- Plastic Bags & Brown grocery bags
- Magazines and junk mail
- Newspaper, glossy paper and paperboard
- Binder/notebook paper, any color
- Stationery and envelopes
- Glass bottles and jars
- Six-pack cartons

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR RECYCLING

- Scrap metal
- Mirrors and windowpane glass
- Aluminum foil boxes
- Plastic wrap
- Light bulbs
- Paper towels, napkins and tissues
- Books (telephone books ok)
- Ceramic pottery, mugs and dishes
- Plastic motor oil bottles

RECYCLING

- Santa Clarita offers state-of-the-art commingled recycling. Cans, bottles, cardboard, newspaper and plastics can all go in your recycling cart.
- Extra cardboard and newspaper must be cut and bundled no larger than 4'x4' in diameter and placed next to your bins.
- An additional recycling cart is available to all residents at no additional charge!



Greenwaste Recycling

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR GREENWASTE RECYCLING

- Grass
- Weeds
- Wood chips
- Tree branches
- Yard trimmings
- Leaves
- Shrubs
- Raw fruit and vegetable scraps

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR GREENWASTE RECYCLING

- Tree stumps
- Bamboo
- Palm tree branches
- Yucca and ice plants
- Soil and dirt
- Rocks and concrete
- Painted and treated wood
- Animal waste



GREENWASTE

- Your greenwaste container is for loose grass clippings, leaves, weeds, pruning/branches up to 4 feet in length and less than 2 inches in diameter.
- Do not bag your greenwaste.
- All greenwaste materials must fit inside your 96-gallon greenwaste cart.
- Don't mix greenwaste with trash, tree stumps, rocks, dirt or other non-acceptable materials. We can't recycle it if it's contaminated.
- Place your 96-gallon greenwaste cart at your curbside the night before your service day. Your greenwaste cart will be serviced every week.
- An additional greenwaste cart is available to all residents at no additional charge!
