BULKY ITEM & HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL OPTIONS

BULKY ITEMS

All City of Santa Clarita (City) households, who have trash service, are entitled to four bulky item pickups per year with a maximum of three items per pickup at no charge. Please provide Waste Management/Blue Barrel Disposal with at least 48 hours notice in order to have the items picked up on your regular collection day. Waste Management can be reached at (661) 259-2398.

City residents may also drop-off unlimited bulky items at Waste Management's facility located at 25772 Springbrook Road, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at no charge.

"Bulky Items" means solid waste that cannot and/or would not typically be accommodated within a trash, recycling or greenwaste cart: furniture (including chairs, sofas, mattresses, and rugs); appliances (including refrigerators – with or without Freon and with the doors removed, ranges, washers, dryers, water heaters, water softeners – with salt removed if applicable, dishwashers, plumbing, small household appliances, and other similar items commonly known as "white goods"; electronic equipment (including stereos, televisions, computers, monitors, cellular phones, VCRs, microwaves, and other similar items commonly known as "brown goods" and "e-waste"); residential wastes (including wood waste, tree branches, scrap wood, limited debris from building remodeling, rocks, sod and earth, in the aggregate not exceeding one cubic yard per collection); clothing; and tires. Bulky items do not include car bodies, construction and demolition debris or items requiring more than two persons to remove.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Residents can dispose of HHW for free at a HHW Roundup or permanent collection center. A permanent collection center is located at 11025 Randall Street, Sun Valley, 91352 and is open Saturday and Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Roundups are scheduled for most weekends and are located throughout Los Angeles County.
