## What is Recycling?

Recycling means helping turn waste into a new product, instead of letting it end up in the landfill.





## What should I recycle?

Recyclable items are often determined based on materials that can be processed at a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF).

In Santa Clarita, some common examples of recyclable items are:

- · Cardboard, paper and paper products
- · Plastic bottles and jugs
- · Glass bottles and jars
- · Aluminum and tin cans
- · Food cartons


Before recycling, make sure all items listed above are empty and dry!



## How Do I Recycle?

Recyclables should be clean and dry before placing in your blue recycling container





#### Should recyclables be bagged?

Answer: recyclable items should <u>NOT</u> be bagged, they should be placed loosely into your recycling container for collection

## What are Organics?


Organic waste is waste that comes directly from something that was once alive or a part of a living thing.

Food scraps, rotten food, grass and leaves are organic waste





## Examples of Organic Waste




Apples come from trees, which are a living thing, meaning items like apple cores or rotten apples are considered organic waste




















# What about food that is still safe to eat?

Food that is still safe to eat, like an unwanted whole piece of fruit or unopened granola bar, might be given to someone else to eat, instead of recycled



Ask if your school has a share table to place safe and unwanted food for others, or save your food for later.

#### What is garbage?

Garbage includes waste that cannot be recycled and is not considered organic material, so it typically ends up in a landfill.

Garbage is not reused and can take hundreds of years to break down in a landfill.





A landfill is a very large open space where garbage is buried in the ground and covered with dirt.

### Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Household Hazardous Waste is a less common type of waste that requires special handling and disposing due to its dangerous nature. HHW needs to be taken to a special center or event that will accept it.

#### Tricky Types of Waste

Sometimes it can be tricky to identify the type of material an item is made of, which makes it difficult to know how to properly dispose of it.



Plastic bags and film can be recycled if you take them to the right place. Otherwise, bags can be reused for food waste or garbage.

Pet waste can carry diseases and should always be collected and disposed of in the trash.
