RAIN BARREL PURCHASE PROGRAM

Rain barrels provide an economical rainwater harvesting option to residents by collecting rainwater from your roof. When installed and maintained properly, rainwater can be used for a multitude of indoor and outdoor household non-potable uses. Using a rain barrel also diverts water from the storm drain system, helping to protect the Santa Clara River from stormwater pollution.

There will be two purchase events held in 2026. Scheduling will be announced on GreenSantaClarita.com.

PESTICIDE POLLUTION PREVENTION

When pesticides get washed into the storm drain, they pollute the Santa Clara River and our groundwater. Avoid washing pesticides off your lawn or garden and refer to the tips below:

1. To prevent pests, avoid leaving food or dirty dishes in sinks, store pet food in an air-tight container and apply caulk to openings on baseboards and around pipes to prevent ants from entering your home.
2. Before applying pesticide, consider a non-toxic alternative like soap and water or diluted vinegar.
3. If you must apply pesticide, make sure to follow the instructions carefully. Spot apply instead of spraying an entire area, avoid application when rain is predicted and leave your sprinklers off for at least 72 hours after application.

ELECTRIC VEHICLES – CHARGE AND GO!

Electric Vehicles (EVs) offer many benefits, including cleaner air, due to zero tailpipe emissions. In addition, they generally have lower maintenance costs than gasoline powered cars, saving money over the life of the vehicle. CONSERVE OUR DRINKING WATER

- Adjust sprinklers to only water landscaping, not hard surfaces, like concrete and sidewalks. Repair any leaks and broken nozzles.
- Consider sweeping in place of using water to clean sidewalks, patios and driveways.

FREE BULKY ITEM COLLECTION

If you need to dispose of bulky items (sofas, mattresses, furniture, etc.), all City households with active trash service are entitled to four FREE bulky item pickups per year, with a maximum of three items per pickup at no charge. Please provide your hauler at least 48 hours notice to have the items picked up on your regular collection day.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

Household batteries, paint and other HHW should not be thrown in the regular trash, but disposed of safely through proper disposal. These items can be taken to the next Los Angeles County HHW/E-Waste Collection Event for FREE. 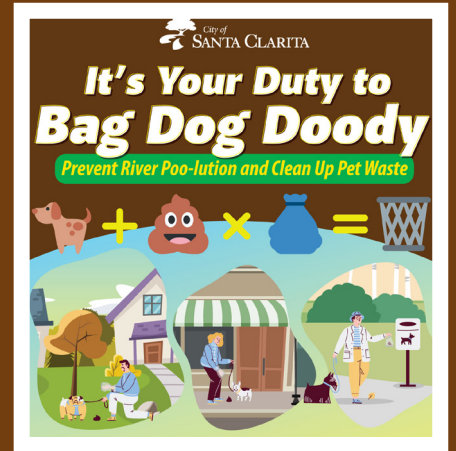

PUT WASTE IN ITS PROPER PLACE

Remember: Only rain down the storm drain! Litter belongs in trash cans, not on the ground.

Use a public container to dispose of your waste or keep a trash bag in your car to dispose of at home.



PREVENT RIVER POO-LUTION

Clean up pet waste at home and in public spaces. Dog waste on the ground contains harmful bacteria that can wash into the City's storm drains and into the Santa Clara River.

- Pick up after your pet using a pet waste bag. Residents can get bags from public pet waste bag stations throughout City parks and paseos.
- Dispose of pet waste in the regular trash container. Pet waste does not belong in your recycling or organics container.
- Do not wash pet waste down the storm drain with a hose.
